

## IF THE SHOE FITS...



As part of their 2D and 3D Art work this year, Year 9 pupils have been researching the work of famous shoe designers including Manolo Blahnik and Patrick Cox, alongside illustrations of shoes by Andy Warhol and sculptural shoes by Claes Oldenburg, Jim Dine and Ellen Bell.

The students created a 2D design for their own shoe, going on to make the shoe in 3D, using cardboard, papier mache and poster paints. The student who created the winning design was presented with art materials, a copy of the book 'Shoes' by Linda O'Keeffe and a congratulatory certificate. A runner-up was also presented with the book and certificate. A further four pupils were also given special commendation certificates.

All of the designs have been entered into a nationwide shoe design competition run by The V&A Museum, with the entries being judged by a panel that includes Jimmy Choo.
