

FORM 2's REPTILE EXPERIENCE



Form 2 got to meet all sorts of reptiles, including snakes, lizards, chameleons and tortoises, at their Reptile Experience. This is a sample of what the children found out from their Experience:

'Today I learnt that the white tree frog could change colour so if it stayed under a log it would change from green to brown. The snakes were very cold when I touched them. A snake's skin is just like bubble wrap. The tortoise was four years old and the chameleon was seven. I enjoyed seeing the tortoise most.'

'I saw a tortoise and his shell is made of bone. He is four years old and his claws are spiky. His bone is called an exoskeleton. When he is scared he hides in his shell. A tortoise lives on land but a turtle lives on the land and in the water.'
