

FORM 5 RSPB BIRDWATCH

Just before the end of term Year 5 pupils took part in the RSPB's national Big Schools' Bird Watch.

A representative from the RSPB, Malcolm Busby, who is also a Milton Country Park ranger, visited Mrs Farmer's Year 5 class to join in with their bird-watching activities and point out different species. The data collected from the bird watch in the school gardens was then sent directly to the RSPB and added to their national data. Mr Busby will visit the class later in the term to discuss the national results and compare them to those collected by the pupils.

Over 40,000 people took part in the national Big Garden Bird Watch last year, and the RSPB are urging people to get involved, so that a snapshot of the country's bird population can be produced.
